Table 1: Number of cases active awaiting a trial (at the end of each month) for cases where a defendant was remanded in custody or remanded on electronically monitored (EM) bail.

Notes for Table 1:

- Data covers cases active in the High Court, District Court and Youth Court where the case is categorised as being in the trial stage of the criminal process.
- A case is counted at each date it was active so the same case may be included in multiple periods within this table.
- A case can have multiple defendants. The remand status is assigned according to that of the defendant on the case, as at the end of each month.
- Where multiple remand statuses are present (multiple defendants), a hierarchy is used to classify the case which follows the order of Custody, EM Bail, Bail, At Large.
- This data is extracted from a live dataset that is used for operational purposes, meaning the data will be updated with late data entry. Therefore, this data may differ to data reported elsewhere with a different extraction date.
- This data was extracted on 05 February 2024.
