

Appendix One: Number and percentage of people in prison who do not have a Case Manager as at 28 February 2026, by prison site and index offence.

Table notes:

- The number of people in prison fluctuates daily due to arrests, releases and court decisions. Corrections currently manages approximately 11,300 people in prison.
- The figures below also include people who have been in prison for fewer than 10 days, and those that have previously had a Case Manager allocated to them but did not have one allocated to them as 28 February 2026. A person may also be in the process of transferring to another prison, where a Case Manager will be allocated to them after the transfer. At times, the allocation of a Case Manager may be delayed due to other professionals supporting them to address health issues, or mental health issues.
- Figures are not directly comparable between prisons. Prison populations vary in size and demographics, including security classifications of the people they manage. Some prisons manage more people on remand while other prisons predominantly manage sentenced prisoners.
