Notes:

- TIA is Training Incentive Allowance.
- TIA is reported by calendar
- This data is for all ages of persons getting TIA.
- This is count of distinct clients paid in the calendar year for any type of TIA assistance.
- TIA assistance includes TIA Pre-Enrolment payments, TIA supplementary assistance for on-going study costs and payments for other one off TIA costs such as books.
- Due to certain types of payments being needed at the beginning of the course of study a large number of clients may receive payments at the beginning of the academic year.
- Because back-dated payments making corrections to client eligibility this reporting may not reconcile exactly with other reporting.
- To protect confidentiality the Ministry of Social Development uses processes to make it difficult to identify an individual person or entity from published data.
- These data tables have had random rounding to base three applied to all cell counts in the table.
- A value of one or two is rounded to three.
- The impact of applying random rounding is that columns and rows may not add exactly to the given column or row totals.
- The published counts will never differ by more than two counts.
