

Appendix One: The number of health and safety incident reports that have been completed during the month of October 2025, broken down by prison

Table notes:

- The scope for injuries includes staff, contractors, prisoners, and others who are not employed by Corrections, where the injury was seen to have incurred through work (this includes prison industries).
- Injuries represent number of events, not the number of people injured.
- Frontline staff are encouraged to report all health and safety incidents, however minor.
- The category of injury also includes injuries that did not require any treatment or intervention.
- Data is retrospectively reviewed and updated regularly, and therefore may be subject to change.
- The numbers of staff, contractors and prisoners vary across Corrections-managed prisons, and therefore caution is urged when comparing the figures below.
