**Notes for Table 1:**

- The Ministry of Justice collates data at the end of each month, not on the first. This means that figures have been provided as at the last day of the month or previous month.
- Jury trials were suspended by her Honour Chief Justice Dame Winkelmann for the period of 18 March 2020 to 3 August 2020.
- Jury summons are sent 8-9 weeks in advance of the expected trial. This means the number of summonses for the months of April to June have not ceased but show a decline in the number of summonses.
- The total amount paid to jurors is shown because the Ministry of Justice does not hold information on average amount paid per hour.
- Expenses are recorded by the month they were paid, not by the month in which they were incurred.
- Expenses include juror fees, childcare, travel and parking which may be submitted and processed in the period after jury service has been completed.

**Notes:**

- Justice Service Areas are geographical groupings of individual court locations for administrative purposes. Prior to June 2017 a different administrative grouping, called Service Delivery Areas, was used.
- There are separate groupings used for Senior Courts.
- This table also includes information on courts that have closed.
- Under legislation, the High Court is a single national court which sits in a number of courthouses in different parts of the country. Judges are permanently located in Wellington, Auckland and Christchurch, along with permanent registries. High Court judges from the three main centres go on circuit to other locations as needed. For administrative purposes, cases are recorded by Court location.
- Under legislation, the District Court is also a single national court which sits in a number of courthouses in different parts of the country. The Youth Court and Family Court are divisions of New Zealand's District Court. Permanent registries are not located at all courthouses. For administrative purposes, cases are recorded by Court location in any geographic breakdown.
