Table notes:

Health NZ has continued to emphasise the importance of incident reporting, which is likely to have led to a higher number of incidents reported.

Central: The information provided for the calendar years are “security incidents” from security orderly incident reports – this produces higher numbers than from reportable events.

Waikato, Palmerston North, Tokoroa, Te Kuiti, and Thames Hospitals: The data in the table supplied captures all requests for security assistance within the ED environment, including routine patient and staff support. Work is underway to segment the data so that genuine security incidents can be more accurately reported in future.
