Notes:

- This only includes priority A and B applications.

- When an applicant completes a Register application staff record the type of accommodation the client is currently staying in. Information is updated when MSD is aware of a change in circumstances.
- Territorial Local Authority (TLA) is based on the main applicant's residential address. This doesn't necessarily indicate where the applicants have requested to live.
- To protect confidentiality the Ministry of Social Development uses processes to make it difficult to identify an individual person or entity from published data.
- These data tables have had random rounding to base three applied to all cell counts in the table.
- Random Rounding does not round to zero. A value of one or two will be rounded to three.
- The impact of applying random rounding is that columns and rows may not add exactly to the given column or row totals.
- The published counts will never differ by more than two counts.
