

Appendix One: Rehabilitation programmes that are currently running, on hold or have been discontinued in the 2023/24 financial year, broken down by Corrections-managed prisons.

Table notes:

- Programmes may be on hold for a number of reasons including staffing levels and resource availability. The programmes on hold in this table do not include programmes that are demand-based such as Short Motivational Programmes, or programmes that have concluded with one group and are scheduled to run another group at the next available time, and programmes that have not yet reached the minimum number of eligible participants to run.
- Some programmes are only available for a targeted population and therefore are not run in all prisons.
- Not all programmes that aid in the rehabilitation and reintegration of people in prison that are on sentences or remand, are included in the table below.
- The decision to disestablish the Short Intervention Programme - Child Sexual Offending programme at Auckland Prison and Rolleston Prison stemmed from an evaluation that commenced in 2019, with the last sessions being delivered in May, July and October 2023 and concluding in February 2024, the programme was formally disestablished in April 2024.
- The decision to disestablish the Drug Treatment Programme (6-month) at Otago Corrections Facility was made in September 2023 due to a change in the prison population at the site.
- Rehabilitation programmes form only part of a person's offender plan. People in prison may also be provided with health services, cultural support services, educational opportunities, vocational and employment training, wrap-around whānau support, reintegration services and transitional accommodation support.

- This table has been compiled following consultation with a number of service groups and is considered accurate as at the end of May 2024 however it is subject to change. Matching people in prison with the right programme at the right time is a complex exercise. The prison population is dynamic and various factors determine when, and where, any people in prison attends a programme.
