

WPQ 38380 (2025). Camilla Belich to the Minister for ACC (13 August 2025):

Since 27 November 2023, how many staff, if any, at ministries, agencies and/or departments for which the Minister is responsible have been made redundant, broken down by month and by (a) voluntary redundancy, and (b) all other forms of redundancy, and of those staff, how many, if any have subsequently been appointed to a new role at the same ministry, agency or department, broken down by employment status (contractor, consultant, permanent, part time) as at 4 August 2025?

ACC advises me that a total of 148 staff were made redundant between 27 November 2023 and 4 August 2025.

The table below shows the breakdown by month.
