Notes for Table 1:

- The data for this response forms part of the Tier 1 statistics. Tier 1 statistics are the key official statistics by which New Zealand's performance as a country is measured. These statistics are published twice a year in March (for calendar year) and September (for financial year). - Not all reconviction periods are fully observable, as insufficient time has elapsed to capture subsequent convictions. For example, individuals convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol in the 2022/23 financial year cannot yet have a three-year reconviction period recorded, as this would only be observed in the 2025/26 financial year.
- Where information does not exist for a measure, a dash (-) is used in the tables.
- This data counts a person once per financial year for their most serious driving under the influence conviction in the year, and only the details of that convicted charge are shown.
- In this data, offences for driving under the influence of alcohol include those specifically related to alcohol in the Australian and New Zealand Standard Offence Classification (ANZSOC):
 - 0132: Driving causing death
 - 0450: Driving causing serious injury
 - 131: Drink or drug driving
 - The ANZSOC group 1331: Drive while licence disqualified or suspended is used to identify offences for driving while disqualified.

- The ANZSOC is used to categorise offences into 17 divisions, within which subdivisions and groups exist. In New Zealand, ANZSOC v2.0.0 is used for all statistics published from July 2025 onwards. More information can be obtained from Stats NZ:
