When reviewing this information please ensure you consider

- Adverse Event data Supplied - The database held by the Health Quality Safety Commission (HQSC) is edited as new information comes to hand, whereas published figures are by necessity a snapshot of a point in time. Event totals always fluctuate after publication because some events are reclassified more accurately after reviews. This means our current totals for any period may not match the published figures.
- Request for events per capita - The database does not report rates of serious adverse events per capita for a number of reasons. There is little value in the results as rates since interactions with health systems per capita (especially secondary health care) vary significantly. Also this is not a true reflection of all adverse events that occur in Health New Zealand districts, since this is only the SAC 1 (sentinel - SAC 1 – Death or harm causing severe loss of function and/or requiring lifesaving intervention) and SAC 2 (serious - Major; harm causing major loss of function and/or requiring significant intervention) events reported to HQSC. If necessary, HQSC can calculate these rates using the Health NZ district population projections calculated by Stats NZ for each year but this will require more time.
