

Appendix One: the number of people in prison who have reported their ethnicity as Māori, broken down by order of Māori ethnicity preference and gender, as at 31 August 2025.

Table notes:

- Ethnicity data uses the most recently self-reported ethnicity at the Receiving Office. Corrections does not attempt to verify or confirm a prisoner's ethnicity.
- People can self-report up to four ethnicity preferences.
- There have been no females who identify as Māori beyond their second preference and therefore these preferences have not been reported.
- Numbers are subject to daily fluctuations in the prison population due to arrests, releases, prisoner movements and court decision.
