

Appendix One: The number of people on remand who have not yet been assigned a Case Manager, as at 18 March 2024, broken down by prison.

Table notes:

- The decision to remand a person in custody is made by a Judge in Court, not Corrections.
- The number of people in prison on remand fluctuates regularly due to arrests, releases and court decisions. Corrections currently manages approximately 9,500 people in prison.
- The figures below also include the people who have been in prison for fewer than 10 days, and those that have previously had a Case Manager allocated to them, but do not have one allocated to them as at 18 March 2024.
- Prisons vary in the number of people they hold, and the classification of people they manage. Some prisons predominantly manage people on remand while other prisons predominantly manage sentenced prisoners.
- Data does not include Auckland South Corrections Facility, which is managed by Serco, not Corrections.
