Notes

ACC does not record redundancy numbers by type of redundancy, such as voluntary or other. However, I am advised that ACC offered a voluntary redundancy process during the organisation-wide change in 2024, which resulted in 62 voluntary redundancies.

Regarding the number of staff who were subsequently reappointed, I am advised that two ACC staff members were made redundant and later re-hired by ACC between 27 November 2023 and 5 June 2026: one on a fixed-term basis and the other on a permanent basis.
