Monitoring of key marine amateur fisher access points As a key part of monitoring recreational fisheries, Fisheries New Zealand is undertaken monitoring at eight key boat ramps within the north east coast north island (FMA1) management area (sampling 60 days per year), and additional October to February monitoring of rock lobster fishing in the CRA 2 area, interviewing fishers as they return from fishing trips. Characterisation of recreational fishing activity for snapper and estimating release mortality Existing monitoring of recreational fishing activity provides information on the size and numbers of landed fish, but does not account for any mortality associated with released fish. This survey collected information from recreational fishers (through direct observation and fisher interviews) about the size, number, and condition of snapper released by fishers while fishing within the SNA 1 management area.
