

Appendix One: Number of health and safety incident reports completed between 1 November 2022 to 31 October 2024.

Table notes:

- Injury events also include injuries to contractors, prisoners and others who are not employed by Corrections.
- Frontline staff are encouraged to report all health and safety incidents, however minor.
- The category of injury also includes injuries that did not require any treatment or intervention.
- Data is retrospectively reviewed and updated regularly, it therefore may be subject to change.
- Additionally, figures provided in response to previous written questions provided the number of health and safety incident reports for a 12-month period. As such, these figures may not be directly comparable to figures previously published elsewhere.
- The numbers of staff, contractors and prisoners vary across Corrections-managed prisons, therefore caution is urged when comparing the figures below.
