The data was extracted on the 1 September 2025 for 2024 reporting year. Data relates to apprentices who completed apprenticeship programmes in 2024.

Industry training data submissions (by Tertiary Education Organisations) occur continually throughout the year. Enrolments may take several months to be processed.

The New Zealand Standard Classification of Education (NZSCED) is a subject-based classification system for courses and qualifications at TEOs in receipt of Government funding. NZSCED has been designed to improve the quality and consistency of statistics collected by the government agencies in relation to tertiary study, and to improve New Zealand's international statistical reporting compliance.

All learner numbers in this information request have been rounded to the nearest five. Due to rounding, the underlying values may not add up exactly to total values.

Results are based on information reported through the Industry Training Register (ITR) and relies on the accuracy of data reported by TEOs.
