

Appendix One: Count and percentage of sentenced and remand women who do not have a Case Manager as at 31 May 2025, by index offence.

Table notes:

- The number of people in prison fluctuates on a daily basis due to arrests, releases and court decisions. Corrections currently manages approximately 800 women in prison.
- The figures below also include women who have been in prison for fewer than 10 days, and those that have previously had a Case Manager allocated to them, but did not have one allocated to them as 31 May 2025. A person may also be in the process of transferring to another prison, where a Case Manager will be allocated to them after the transfer. At times, allocation to Case Manager may be delayed due to other professionals supporting them through health issues, or mental health issues.
- Data is broken down by most serious offence type, however, prisoners may be imprisoned for multiple offence types.
