Camilla Belich to the **Minister for ACC** (5 June 2026): How many financial settlements, if any, have been entered into with employees, former employees, contractors, or office holders by any agency, department, Crown entity, company, or other organisation for which the Minister is responsible since 27 November 2023, broken down by organisation, total cost, and year, as at 5 June 2026?

Since 27 November 2023, ACC has entered into 46 settlement agreements: 11 with payments and 35 with no payment. The total paid across the financial settlements was \$1,045,381.

The table below shows these settlements by financial year, including total cost, number of financial settlements, zero-cost settlements, and confidential settlements as at 5 June 2026.

Notes:

Non-disclosure agreements are typically used only where commercial sensitivity is involved, such as procurement, investment, or resolving employment disputes. In employment disputes, they usually form part of a confidential settlement agreement rather than being stand-alone documents.

Confidentiality clauses were included in all 46 settlement agreements.
