Notes:

- This does not include clients on the transfer register.
- The time on waitlist measure calculates the number of days since an application was first confirmed on the waitlist as an A or B priority until the end of the reporting period.
- If an application moves from B priority to A priority, their time on waitlist result will be reported in the A priority measure from the point they were confirmed on the waitlist as a B application.
- The reverse is applicable for applications that shift from an A priority to a B priority.

- If an applicants needs change and they move from the C or D list to an A or B priority, the time on waitlist will be from the point that applicant was confirmed on the A or B list until the end of the reporting period.
