

Appendix One: The number of people in prison that are currently on a waitlist to attend a rehabilitation service, broken down by prison and rehabilitation service type, as at 31 October 2025

Tables notes:

- There are 773 people on the AOD assessment waitlist. They are awaiting assessment to determine which, if any AOD treatment programme best matches their level of AOD need.
- The AOD High Intensity Programme with a waitlist of 102 people, the AOD Moderate Intensity Programme with a waitlist of 40 people, and the AOD Low Intensity Programme with a waitlist of 3 people, cannot be broken down by prison as people may be transferred to different prisons to attend the programmes depending on availability.
- Those waitlisted for 1:1 psychology treatment have also been included as the request asked for those waitlisted for a psychology rehabilitation service, and did not specify a psychology programme.
- Not all programmes are delivered in every prison, a person may be counted multiple times if they are on a waitlist for more than one programme.
- Data provided is manually recorded at each site and is provided to the best of Corrections' ability.
- Waitlists are national and people regularly transfer to attend programmes, so the prison they are at currently may not reflect where they will complete a programme.
