

Appendix One: The number of people in Corrections-managed prisons that are currently on a waitlist to attend a rehabilitation service, as at 30 April 2024.

Table notes:

- A person may be counted multiple times if they are on a waitlist for more than one programme.
- The 6-month Drug Treatment Programme with a waitlist of 377 people, and the 12-month Drug Treatment Programme with a waitlist of 51 people, cannot be broken down by prison as people may be transferred to different prisons depending on availability. Please note, the 12-month Drug Treatment Programme is only delivered at Hawke's Bay Regional Prison.
- Te Waka Anga Mua and Te hau Ora O Tan are Māori Pathways programmes delivered at Northland Region Corrections Facility. There is a current waitlist of 24 people.
- Tēnei Au is a Māori Pathways programme delivered at Hawkes Bay Regional Prison. There is a current waitlist of 11 people.
- The Tikanga Māori Programme is delivered at all prisons, and does not have a waitlist.
- The data provided is manually recorded at each site and is provided to the best of Corrections' ability.
- A person's eligibility to participate in any particular programme can depend on a number of factors, including their security classification, identified risks and willingness to engage. Some people may be on a waitlist if it is not the appropriate time in their sentence to complete a programme.
- The data below represents the current location of people on waitlists.
- Data may be subject to change over time as a result of retrospective assurance amendments being made.
