

Details of minerals permits granted since 1 November 2022 that overlap Conservation land are provided in the table below. Note:

- the table provides information on permits that overlap present day Conservation land; some overlaps may not have existed at the time of granting due to boundary adjustments or changes in land classification
- the degree to which the permits overlap Conservation land ranges significantly – from just over 0 per cent to 100 per cent
- the table includes information on permits that are not currently active – ie were granted on or after 1 November 2022 but have subsequently expired, been surrendered or have a surrender application pending decision
- some permits cross regional boundaries. The table categorises permits by their primary region.
