

Appendix One: Number and percentage of sentenced and remand women prisons who do not have a Case Manager, as at 31 August 2025, by index offence.

Table notes:

- The number of people in prison fluctuates on a daily basis due to arrests, releases and court decisions. Corrections currently manages approximately 800 women in prison.
- The figures below also include women who have been in prison for fewer than 10 days, and those who have previously had a Case Manager allocated to them, but did not have one allocated to them as at 31 August 2025. A person may also be in the process of transferring to another prison, where a Case Manager will be allocated to them after the transfer. At times, allocating a Case Manager may be delayed due to other professionals supporting them to address health issues, or mental health issues.
- Data is broken down by most serious offence type, however, prisoners may be imprisoned for multiple offence types.
