

Appendix One: The number of people in prison that are currently on a waitlist to attend a rehabilitation programme, broken down by prison, as at 31 March 2025.

Table notes:

- Not all programmes are delivered in every prison, a person may be counted multiple times if they are on a waitlist for more than one programme.
- Te Waka Anga Mua is a Māori Pathways programme delivered at Northland Region Corrections Facility. There is currently no one on a waitlist.
- Tēnei Au, Tēnei Au is a Māori Pathways programme delivered at Hawkes Bay Regional Prison. There is a current waitlist of 20 people.
- Due to a temporary glitch in Corrections' recording system, the number of people awaiting assessment to determine their level of AOD need is not available. Work is underway to rectify this glitch.
- Te Ira Wahine is an intensive Kaupapa Māori AOD treatment programme that is delivered at Auckland Region Women's Corrections Facility. This programme does not have a waitlist.
- The data provided is manually recorded at each site and is provided to the best of Corrections' ability.
- A person's eligibility to participate in any particular programme can depend on a number of factors, including their security classification, identified risks and willingness to engage. Some people may be on a waitlist if it is not the appropriate time in their sentence to complete a programme. The figures below show the number of people that have been identified as eligible and likely to benefit from these programmes, and are therefore placed on waitlists to attend a programme when it is reasonable to do so.
- Data below represents the current location of people on waitlist.
- Data may be subject to change over time as a result of retrospective assurance amendments being made.
- Some of these figures have been extracted from live databases and are accurate as at the day of their extraction.
