

PQ 74066 (2024): From 1 January 2018 to 18 November 2024, how many people, if any, have been included in New Zealand's annual refugee quota under the Medical/Disabled category, broken down per year by primary applicant and family members associated with the primary applicant, and ethnicity?

Table: The table below provides the number of individuals who have arrived in New Zealand under the Medical/Disabled category of the Refugee Quota between 1 January 2018 and 18 November 2024, broken down by year, nationality, principal applicants, and secondary applicants.

Please note that information has been provided for nationality as ethnicity data is not available in a reportable format. Some numbers have been aggregated, and some numbers less than five have not been provided to maintain confidentiality obligations under s151 of the Immigration Act 2009.
