PQ 6968 (2019): How many individuals subject to a community-based sentence or order have been reconvicted and sentenced to a new sentence managed by Corrections, for offences committed from 1 February 2019 to 20 February 2019.

I am advised that a total of 27 offenders re-offended while subject to a community-based sentence or order administered by Corrections from 1 February 2019 to 20 February 2019. Three of these offenders were subject to both a community-based sentence and a community-based order in this period, meaning the totals provided above add to more than 27.

All reconvictions and sentencing matters are dependent on Court proceedings.

Community-based sentences administered by Corrections include: Community Work, Supervision, Intensive Supervision, Community Detention, and Home Detention.

Community-based orders administered by Corrections include: Release on Conditions, Post Detention Conditions, Parole, Returning Offender Orders, and Extended Supervision Orders.
