Paerata

- **Supplier** - An internally developed tool created in collaboration with Arinco, leveraging Microsoft's AI platform as the underlying environment
- **Purpose** - a walled-garden generative AI tool built for use in-house using Chat GPT, operating within the Azure environment. All staff at Treasury have access to this tool.
- **Contract value** - Build and improvement cost of \$60k, and approx \$1700/month depending on usage (includes DPMC, NEMA and Treasury)

- **Supplier** - Microsoft
- **Purpose** - generative AI-powered conversational assistant grounded in enterprise data (files, emails, chats) for searching, summarizing, creating, and automating tasks.
- **Contract value** - \$33K spent to date
- **Commissioning** - March 2025

- **Supplier** - Anthropic
- **Purpose** - Used as an on-demand technical collaborator for tasks such as Code development and debugging, Literature review and synthesis, Technical writing, Data visualisation, and Ad hoc knowledge tasks.
