Caveats
Data are as at 6-November-2025 for the reporting year 2025 and has been sourced through administrative data held by the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC).
Data relate to Youth Guarantee (Levels 1 and 2 on the NZQCF only) funding.
There were no requests for additional funding Qualification Delivery at Levels 1 and 2 on the NZQCF (DQ1-2) as the fund was fully allocated during the initial investment round.
This data have been compiled specifically to respond to this question. It uses administrative data collected by the Tertiary Education Commission for the purposes of funding tertiary education and relies on the accuracy of data reported by TEOs.
