

Appendix One: The number of people in prison that are currently on a waitlist to attend a rehabilitation programme, broken down by prison and rehabilitation service type, as at 31 July 2025.

Table notes:

- The AOD High Intensity Programme with a waitlist of 57 people, the AOD Moderate Intensity Programme with a waitlist of 69 people, and the AOD Low Intensity Programme with a waitlist of 10 people, cannot be broken down by prison as people may be transferred to different prisons to attend the programmes depending on availability.
- Additionally, 968 people are awaiting assessment to determine their level of AOD need and which, if any AOD treatment programme best matches their level of AOD need.
- Data provided for those waitlisted for psychology programmes shows the prison they are currently at and not necessarily the prison they are waitlisted to attend the programme at.
- Those waitlisted for 1:1 psychology treatment have also been included as the request asked for those waitlisted for a psychology rehabilitation service, and did not specify a psychology programme.
- Not all programmes are delivered in every prison, a person may be counted multiple times if they are on a waitlist for more than one programme.
- Data provided is manually recorded at each site and is provided to the best of Corrections' ability.
