

Appendix One: The number of people in prison who have not yet been assigned a case manager, as at 30 April 2024, broken down by prison.

Table notes:

- The number of people in prison fluctuates regularly due to arrests, releases and court decisions. Corrections currently manages approximately 9,600 people in prison.
- The figures below also include the people who have been in prison for fewer than 10 days, and those that have previously had a Case Manager allocated to them, but do not have one allocated to them as 30 April 2024.
- Prisons vary in the number of people they hold, and the classification of people they manage. Some prisons predominantly manage people on remand while other prisons predominantly manage sentenced prisoners.
